This Week's Kingdom Quest Lesson:

Paul in Corinth

Take Home Point:

Speak up for Jesus!

Drive Time Home

Tickler Question: What exciting event did Gordy, the puppet, talk about today? How is that like the point for today's lesson? *(Gordy had a mouse as a pet, but it got loose in the house. It was exciting. The most exciting news we can share is what Jesus has done for us.)*

Select questions and adapt for your family.

God Time at Home

FOR STARTERS: Have each family member share one very exciting thing that has happened to them. Then say: "Paul was very excited about telling others what Jesus had done for him. We, too, should speak up for Jesus."

READ THE BIBLE: Acts 18:1-17

KEY VERSE: 1 Peter 3:15, *"But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have."* (NIV)

TALK ABOUT IT: What did Paul do while he was in the city of Corinth? *(Acts 18:3-5. He made tents and discussed the scripture in the synagogue. Later he devoted all his time to teaching the word of God. He assured the Jews that Jesus is the Messiah.)* What did Paul do when some of the Jews opposed and insulted him? *(Acts 18:6. He shook the dust from his clothes and said he was not responsible for their not believing and took the Good News to non-Jewish people.)* Did Paul give up preaching about Jesus? *(Acts 18:7-8. No. He left the synagogue and went to a house next door.)* What happened because Paul kept preaching? *(Acts 18:8. The synagogue leader and his whole family came to believe in Jesus as well as many other Corinthians.)* What did God tell Paul in a vision? *(Acts 18:9. "Don't be afraid to speak out! Don't be silent! I'm with you. No one will attack you or harm you.")* Why do you think God appeared to Paul in a vision? *(Maybe Paul was feeling discouraged.)* How do you think Paul felt to hear from the Lord? *(Encouraged.)* Does God promise the same to us?

PRAYER POWER: Pray for Holy Spirit excitement to **speak up for Jesus* about all the wonderful things he has done.
