This Week's Kingdom Quest Lesson:
Pentecost Power

Take Home Point:
The Holy Spirit gives us power to witness.

Drive Time Home

Tickler Question: Tell me how you used a balloon, a straw and string. How was this like the Holy Spirit? *(The Holy Spirit is like the balloon that gives us power to bring the good news of Jesus to the world.)*

Select questions and adapt for your family.

God Time at Home

FOR STARTERS: Play a game with straws and a cotton ball. Let each person use his or her straw to try to blow the cotton ball off the edge of another person's side of the table. Say: "The Holy Spirit is sometimes pictured as wind. He moves us where God can use us to share the Good News of Jesus."

READ THE BIBLE: Acts 2:1-41—Pentecost

KEY VERSE: Acts 1:8, *"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes to you. Then you will be my witnesses to testify about me in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."*

TALK ABOUT IT: How did the Holy Spirit show his presence on Pentecost? *(Acts 2:2-3. A sound like violently blowing wind came from the sky and filled the whole house where the believers were staying. Tongues of fire appeared and rested on each believer.)* What strange thing did the believers do after receiving the power of the Holy Spirit? *(Acts 2:4. They began to speak in other languages.)* Why do you think Peter, who earlier denied Jesus three times, could now preach such a powerful sermon about Jesus and his resurrection? *(The Holy Spirit gave him the power.)* What was the result of Peter's powerful sermon? *(Acts 2:41. 3,000 people believed and accepted Jesus and were baptized that day.)* How can you and I be like Peter and the disciples according to Acts 1:8? *(With the power of the Holy Spirit, we can testify about Jesus and expect amazing results.)*

PRAYER POWER: Pray for each family member to be filled with the Holy Spirit and receive power to tell others about Jesus' amazing love. Pray for God to show them the direction he wants them to go in their lives.

Family Time Option

One day this week, try...

Have each family member think of three people who need to know how God loves them and has sent Jesus as their Savior. Ask the Holy Spirit to help each member share the good news of Jesus with these people. Check back during the next week to see how the Holy Spirit has helped each person witness.

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
