God Talk At Home

This Week's Kingdom Quest Lesson:

Paul in Rome

Take Home Point:

Help 'link' others to Jesus.

Drive Time Home

Tickler Question: Did you make links for a paper chain today? Show me. What are some of the names on it? *(In Kingdom Quest, kids made a paper chain demonstrating how they can be a link to Jesus, reaching others with his love and message.)*

God Time at Home

Select questions and adapt for your family.

FOR STARTERS: Encourage each person to name someone that told him or her about Jesus. They were links in a chain that helped get him/her connected to Jesus.

READ THE BIBLE: Acts 28:16-31, Philippians 1:12-14

KEY VERSE: Acts 28:31, *"He spread the message about God's kingdom and taught very boldly about the Lord Jesus Christ..."*

TALK ABOUT IT: How do you think Paul felt about living in chains? How did God use Paul's circumstances for his glory? *(Paul was a Roman citizen, so was protected by a guard. Even though he was under arrest, people could come and visit him. No one stopped Paul from sharing the Good News of Jesus while he was there.)*

Even though Paul was imprisoned, instead of feeling trapped by the chains, Paul saw himself as a link to help others get free. Can you think of any hardships we may face that God can use for his purposes and bring others to Jesus? *(Answer to prayers in difficulties, healing from sickness, even testimony of belief in everlasting life when one is on his/her deathbed.)*

PRAYER POWER: Have family members think about people that they can link to Jesus. Then ask God to help all be bold in their love, witness and encouragement to help link these people to Jesus.

Family Time Option

One day this week, try...

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS: As a family, make a paper chain and put names of people from your neighborhood or circle of friends with whom you would like to share the love and message of Jesus on the links. Pray for them regularly.
