## Birth

### Faith Step: Faith Chest

Session #1: How to Give a Legacy of Faith to Your Child

1. Begin with the end in mind.
2. Create a Christ-centered atmosphere in your home.
3. Show & Tell – Two key ways to pass faith to your child.

Session #2: How to Bless Your Child

1. Bless your child with words.
2. Bless your child by building trust.
3. Bless your child with prayer.

Session #3: Baptism (*option*)

1. What is baptism?
2. What does a child spiritually need?
3. How to prepare for baptism.

## Two year-olds

### Faith Step: *Picture Bible*

Session #1: How to Share Faith with Your Two Year-old

1. Begin with the end in mind.
2. Be intentional.
3. Look for the teachable moments.

Session #2: Spiritual Parenting

1. Be God's representative.
2. Protect your child spiritually.
3. Love your child enough to set limits.

Session #3: Bless Your Child

1. Read the Book – Bring the blessings of Bible reading into your home.
2. Pray the virtues – 31 prayers to pray for your child's character development.
3. Give a Blessing.

## Faith Legacy Series: Scope and Sequence - 1

## **Four year-olds**

### **Faith Step: *Worship Kit***

#### Session #1: How to Worship God

1. Worship is saying, "I love you, God."
2. Worship happens as both lifestyle and planned routine.
3. Your child's worship life begins with you.

#### Session #2: Worship and Media

1. What's filling your child's mind?
2. Use the power of video.
3. Use the power of music.

#### Session #3: Bless Your Child With a Life of Worship

1. Have God-talk at home.
2. Fill the kit.
3. Bless your child.

## **Six year-olds (1<sup>st</sup> Grade)**

### **Faith Step: *Towel and Basin***

#### Session #1: How to Have Family Devotions With Your Six-Year-Old

1. Begin with the end in mind.
2. Begin with family devotions.
3. Watch for the teachable moment.

#### Session #2: How to Teach your Child to Serve

1. Teach servanthood by example.
2. Use your gifts to serve.
3. Plan to serve together.

#### Session #3: How to Teach Your Child to Give

1. Everything belongs to God.
2. Teach your child money management.
3. Bless your child.

## **Eight year-olds (3<sup>rd</sup> Grade)**

### **Faith Step: *First Bible***

Session #1: How to Have Family Devotions

1. Why are family devotions so hard?
2. Use the Book – the power of God’s Word.
3. Choose a plan that fits.

Session #2: Use the Bible in Your Personal Devotions

1. Why personal Bible reading?
2. How to use the Bible in personal devotions.
3. Help your child learn to love reading the Bible.

Session #3: How to Be Blessed With the Bible

1. Grab hold of the Bible.
2. Understand the theme of the Bible.
3. Bless your child with the Bible.

## **Ten year-old Boys (5<sup>th</sup> and/or 6<sup>th</sup> Grade)**

### **Faith Step: *God’s Plan for a Man***

#### ***Father-Son Retreat***

Session #1: Be Courageous (*Friday night*)

1. Campfire Devotion – David and Goliath.
2. Father-Son conversation: What giants have you faced?
3. First Blessing

Session #2: Be Honorable (*Saturday morning*)

1. Joseph’s life of honor.
2. Video, Panel on Sex.
3. Second Blessing

Session #3: Be Faithful to the End (*Saturday afternoon*)

1. Father/Son trust walk.
2. Jesus’ faithfulness, The Race.
3. Third Blessing.

Blessing Event: Passing the baton

**Ten year-old Girls (5<sup>th</sup> and/or 6<sup>th</sup> Grade)**  
**Faith Step: God's Design for His Daughters**  
**Mother-Daughter Retreat**

Session #1: Be Cherished (*Friday night*)

1. We long to be cherished.
2. Caution: Our need to be accepted can lead to regrets.
3. God has designed us to be cherished by him. Cherish letters from parents.  
Charm bracelet: *cherished, pure, faithful.*

Session #2: Be Pure (*Saturday morning*)

1. Purity is about your heart, soul, and body.
2. Sex is an incredible gift from God: Video, Panel on Sex.
3. Christ helps us be pure.

Session #3 Be Faithful to the End (*Saturday afternoon*)

1. To be faithful is to *BE there*: Mary, Jesus' Mother, at the cross.
2. To be faithful is to *trust*: Mother/daughter trust walk.
3. To be faithful is to *hope*: Look to the cross. Moms bless their daughters.

## **Faith Legacy: Preteen and Teen Years**

- 7<sup>th</sup> Grade "A Teenage Home Where Everybody Wins... (and nobody kills each other)"  
Discipleship Skills: Honoring Each Other, Communication, Conflict Resolution. Blessing object – "you talk i listen" cards.
- Make the teen years great by honoring each other
  - Create an Atmosphere of Honor
  - When in conflict, honor each other
- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade "What's God Been Saying to You Lately?"  
Discipleship Skills: Personal Devotional Time, Prayer, God Talk in the Home
- God Wants to Speak to You Today
  - Be Intentional With a Plan
  - Connect as a Family
- 9<sup>th</sup> Grade "A teenage home where sex isn't a dirty word"  
Discipleship Skills: Understanding the Opposite Sex, Godly Sexuality, Boundaries in Dating

- 10<sup>th</sup> Grade “Looking Ahead - Life After High School”  
Discipleship Skills: Discerning God’s Will for Your Future, Planning for College or Career
- What’s is God’s Purpose for My Life
  - Becoming the You that You Were Meant to Be
  - It’s Time to Plan
- 11<sup>th</sup> Grade “Looking ahead: How to choose a spouse”  
Discipleship Skills: Principles for Godly Dating, Honoring Your Future Spouse, Keys to Solid Friendships
- 12<sup>th</sup> Grade “Looking ahead: Remember your spiritual roots”  
Discipleship Skill: Remain Steadfast in Faith, How to Connect to the Church, Being Part of the Body of Christ
