



Basin and Towel Kit Instructions

Included:

- 22" x 30" flour sack towel
- "Touch The World" iron-on transfer
- 1 oz. shiny bright blue fabric paint

Not included:

- Iron
- Your child's hands 😊
- 22" piece of foil, saran wrap, or wax paper
- Paint shirts for you and your child



Step 1: Apply "Touch The World" Iron-On Transfer

Preheat your iron to the highest setting. **DO NOT USE STEAM!** Iron out the wrinkles on the towel prior to transfer application. Iron on a flat, hard surface. Do Not Use An Ironing Board. Make sure the towel is completely dry.

Trim your "Touch The World" iron-on transfer in to a circle, leaving a 1/8" border on the outside of the logo.

Place your transfer, image side down (so you can read the transfer correctly), centered on the towel about 4 ½" from the bottom edge of the towel. Iron transfer image for at least 2 minutes, using maximum even pressure, highest heat, overlapping all the edges. Allow printed area to cool completely before removing the transfer paper.

Step 2: Applying Fabric Paint Handprints

(Read thoroughly before applying any paint)

Put paint shirts on yourself and your child. **Use fabric paint carefully as it cannot be removed from clothing.** Your child's handprints will be placed on each side of the "Touch The World" transfer. (See the picture on the next page.)

Place the towel on a hard surface with a piece of foil, wax paper, or saran wrap underneath where the handprints will be placed. This is to protect the hard surface from paint and will stay under the towel and be peeled off only when the handprints are completely dry.

Be prepared to work quickly, so paint does not get too dry.

Place a quarter size glob of fabric paint in the palm of each of your child's hands. Gently rub the two hands together and check for full, thick paint coverage (make sure fingertips and all crevices are covered). Repeat this process with another glob in each palm. Repeat as necessary. You really can't use too much paint.

Let your child know to spread their fingers and that YOU WILL PRESS THEIR HANDS DOWN on the towel. Hold both wrists and press handprints firmly on the towel, one on each side of the "Touch The World" transfer, as if your child is holding the world. Lift your child's hands up carefully.

Admire your child's "handiwork".

Clean-up: Wash hands, paint will come off easily. Run water gently so paint doesn't splash. Use paper towel to dry hands. Rinse sink out immediately.

After the fabric paint is completely dry, you may use an additional towel on the back side of the handprints towel and iron to "set" the paint. Do not iron directly on the fabric paint!

**Washing should not be necessary, but allow at least one day before washing imaged, fabric painted item. Do not bleach. If necessary, iron on the back side with a towel in between your printed towel and the iron.
