

Directions for Making a Simple Headpiece

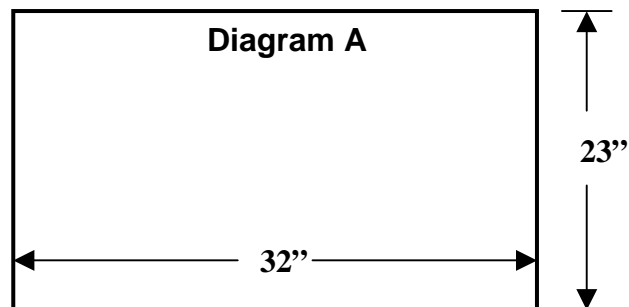
Supplies needed:

Tape measure

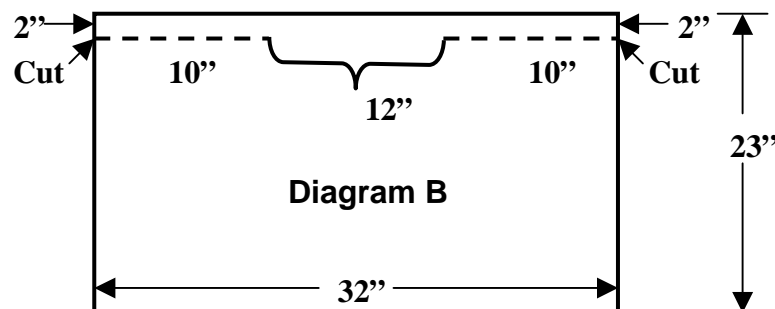
1 yd of fabric polyester or broadcloth (makes two headpieces)

scissors

- 1) Measure head of the shepherd (either child or adult) about 22".
- 2) For width of rectangle add 10" to the size of head or about 32".
- 3) Cut a rectangle from the fabric 32" wide and 23" long (the length will be consistently 23" for each head piece).



- 4) Measure 2" from the top of the length and cut 10" from both edges leaving about a 12" center.



- 5) *Option: Sew 1/2" hem or serge around the edge of the entire headpiece*
