- Polystyrene¹
- razor cutter³
- duct tape or clear packing tape¹
- aluminum foil
- spray adhesive²
- twine³

Shield:

- aluminum serving tray
- elastic²
- glue³

Priestly Vest or Ephod:

- poster board²
- fabric²
- costume gemstones²
- glue

Waves:

- wooden boards or dowel sticks³
- poster board²
- paint³
- fabric²
- spray adhesive if using fabric²

Treasure Chest & Ark of the Covenant:

- cardboard boxes
- gold spray paint³
- wooden poles or dowels (Ark)³
